## Competency Based Trainers

Assessment Records need to be fully completed—this includes:

- Participant's full name (not initials)
- Date of Birth
- Full Address with Postcode
- Contact phone number
- All records must be signed and dated by the trainer and participant.
- Full CURRENT trainer number must be written down

In future—if all sections are not completed Assessment Records will be returned to the trainer for correction (which will delay the issuing of the certificates).

Please also ensure that a completed ERF is sent with the Assessment Records. Assessment Records sent on their own will not be processed until we receive a completed ERF.

### Pool Lifeguard Course

- Minimum age for this course is 16 years old.
- Certificates will not be issued to participants under this age.

RLSSA has launched a water safety program targeted at people 55 years and over. The Grey Medallion is a variation of the Bronze Medallion and aims to promote a healthy, active and safe aquatic lifestyle for people over 55.

The program has four key components:

1. Water Safety Knowledge
2. Resuscitation and Emergency Care
3. Aquatic Exercise
4. Personal Survival and Lifesaving Skills.

The course will be held at Burpengary Aquatic and Fitness Centre on Saturday 24 May 2008 from 1-5pm.
