REMOTE WATER SAFETY - ROYAL LIFE SAVING ARRIVES BY CHOPPER TO COBBOLD GORGE

Cobbold Gorge is unique, hidden away within the rugged sandstone formations of North Queensland. The overall length of the gorge is about six (6) kilometers and consists of a series of water-holes and rock falls, however only the last 500 metres is accessible by a flat bottom boat.

The gorge is located approximately six (6) hours north west of Townsville. Carolyn Asher and Colleen Freeman set out from Townsville at 6.00am on 29th September 2011 and drove to the Lynd Junction, which is a three (3) hour drive, sorted out the gear, which was then taken out to the gorge by road. Carolyn & Colleen bordered a very small helicopter provide by The Salvation Army Outback Flying Service Chaplain Simon, and flew over the amazing country side to the cattle property, that is home to ten thousand (10.000) head of Brahman cattle on Robin Hood Stations, an area of 1284 square kilometers. Its history dates back to early gold rush days.

After a forty five (45) minute helicopter flight, the Trainers were straight into the water safety program, which was taught in an above ground pool at the side of the gorge. These children are educated through the school of the air. Seventy five (75) children (ageing from 6 months to 14 years) from surrounding properties, attended an extensive five (5) day program of Swimming, Life Saving & Water Safety.

June Cotter from Mareeba joined the group on the second day to help with the program. For a lot of these children, their only place to swim is in animal troughs, the creek or river. The children enjoyed the challenges that the Royal Life Saving Trainers set for them and there was obviously lots of fun. Royal Life Saving Queensland provided water bottles, lunch bags and caps for the children, and they appreciated this support.
