Professor John Pearn:

Professor John Pearn is the Deputy Head of the School of Medicine at the University of Queensland; and since 1986 has been the Professor Paediatrics & Child Health at the Royal Children's and Mater Children's Hospitals in Brisbane. He has been a senior Consultant Paediatrician since 1970. He is the author of four hundred papers in the international refereed medical literature and is the author of seventeen books, primarily to do with clinical medicine and medical history. In 2002 he was awarded the Howard Williams Medal by the Royal Australasian College of Physicians. Professor Pearn has had a second career in military medicine and in 2001 retired as the Surgeon General of the Australian Defence Force after 36 years in the Reserves, with five periods of operational full-time service. He has been a member of the Royal Life Saving Society - Australia (RLSSA) since 1976. John was appointed as National Medical Adviser to RLSSA in 2002 and has represented RLSSA on the Australian Resuscitation Council and on the International Life Saving Federation Medical Committee since 2003.

Gary Johnson is the Technical Officer at Tamworth Regional Council overseeing the operation of their six public swimming facilities. Gary's background includes involvement in still water, surf and aero medical operations.

In 2001 Gary was a Lifeguard on duty at a facility when a young boy drowned. Despite best efforts the boy could not be revived. This saw Gary become a prominent witness during the subsequent Coroner's Inquest. The drowning and the eight months leading up to the inquest were a defining time for everyone, from the child's parents, all the way through to the Council operating the centre.

Gary has since devoted a lot of time assisting the aquatic industry to not only prevent drowning, but to better prepare for such events. Gary's presentation at the Conference will give facility managers and operators a behind the scenes look at the Coroner's process and provides practical ideas for improving your facility's position on both prevention & preparation.
