John is currently the Executive Director and Director of Training of the Divers Alert Network Asia-Pacific (DAN Asia-Pacific), which he founded in 1994 in an effort to improve the safety of scuba diving within the Asia-Pacific. In 2007 he received an Order of Australia award for services to scuba diving safety, resuscitation and first aid.


